

Mounting Into Cards

Before you mount your finished cross stitch into a card, you might want to wash it first, use a mild detergent and rinse thoroughly. Once it is dry press it using a warm iron with a cloth in between the cross stich and the iron. Use Iron on Villean (which can be obtained from all good Haberdasheries), cut a piece of villean to the size of the cross stitch. Place the cross stitch face down and with the shiny side of the villean to the back of the cross stitch. Then with a cloth over both use a hot iron to stick them both together.


Using the card that you want to put the cross stitch in, place it over the finished work and making sure that it is centered use a pencil to mark around the edges. Cut to fit the card, make sure that it is slightly smaller than the card. Depending on if you are using an oval, circular or other shaped card aperture. Make sure that the doubled sided sticky tape is all the way around the aperture and edges so that it secures the finished work into the card.



Using double sided sticky tape, place it all around the card, as shown above. Peel the backing off and place the cross stich into place. Please make sure that before you press it firmly into place that it is centered. Any adjustments can be made at this point.



On the back of the cross stitch use double sided sticky tape, place it all around the card, as shown above. Peel the backing off and fold the side marked A, onto B, smooth all around.



Then fold the side of the card marked C onto B.



To make sure that everything is secure, place the finished card under a pile of books, or some other heavy object. If possible, try to leave it overnight. Happy Stitching
